Candidate are required to pay, the sum of One Hundred Thousand (#100,000:00) only, being application and processing fees, to **NITP Access Bank Account No. 0022349928**.

Completed Application Forms accompanied by evidence of payment of application and processing fees, academic and professional credentials as well as all other relevant documents (photocopies) must be submitted to the National Secretariat on or before, the 15<sup>th</sup> of May, 2024.

**Note:**

1. Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted
2. Only those who are prima-facie qualified will be invited for interview
3. Those with financial arrears of any kind, either to the Institute or TOPREC, will not be considered

4. Candidates must ensure that their proposers and sponsors are financially up to date in their obligations to the Institute and TOPREC. Any outstanding amounts against them must be settled fully, before a candidate can be deemed to have been duly proposed and sponsored for election into the College of Fellows
